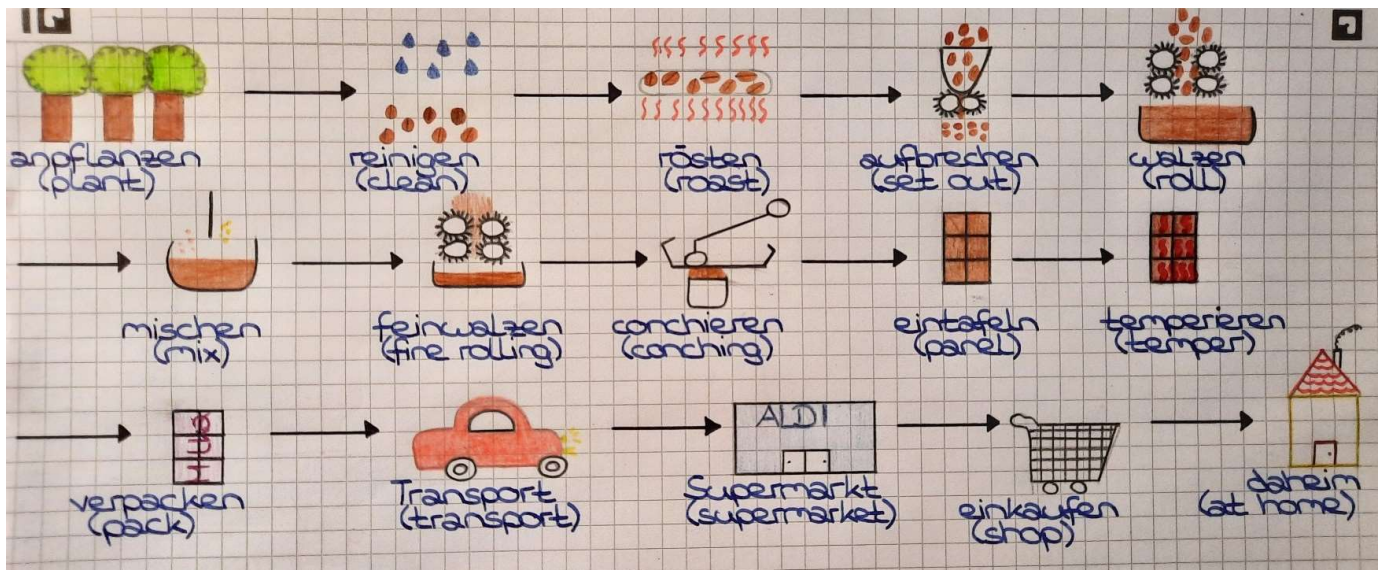
My favourite chocolate is the cow spots chocolate from Milka.
